Breast Cancer is cancer that forms in the tissues of the breast. While it occurs in both men and women, male breast cancer is rare.

DID YOU KNOW?

About 1% of breast cancer is found in men

Screening mamograms help find cancer when there are no signs or symptoms



DID YOU KNOW?

Breast cancer is the 2nd leading cause of death from cancer in American women

Did you know?

Different people have different symptoms of breast cancer. Some people do not have any signs or symptoms at all.

DID YOU KNOW

Everyone should become familiar with how their breast and chest area feels so they can talk with their doctor if they notice any lump or change.

Symptoms of breast cancer

New lump in the breast or underarm

Thickening or swelling in part of the breast

Skin dimpling, irritation, redness, or flakiness on the nipple or breast

Pulling in of the nipple

Nipple discharge

Pain in any area of the breast

Any change in size or shape of the breast

If you notice a lump or other symptoms, see your doctor.

MEN AND WOMEN CAN GET CLINICAL BREAST EXAMS AND OTHER TESTS TO DETERMINE IF A SYMPTOM IS DUE TO CANCER OR ANOTHER BREAST CONDITION.
